## Public Path Extinguishment Order

### Highways Act 1980

#### Staffordshire County Council Public Path Extinguishment Order 2012 Public Footpath No. 15 Burntwood Parish

This Order is made by Staffordshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order is not needed for public use.

#### BY THIS ORDER

1. The public right of way over land situate at Burntwood and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part I of the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
2. Notwithstanding this Order where immediately before the date upon which the footpath is extinguished there is apparatus under, in, on, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

##### Description of Path to be Extinguished

That length of Public Footpath No. 15 Burntwood Parish commencing at its junction with Cannock Road (point A on the Order plan, Grid Ref: SK034095) and running in a generally southerly direction for approximately 63 metres (point B on the Order plan, Grid Ref: SK034095) before heading in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 211 metres to its junction with Cobbett Road (point C on the Order plan, Grid Ref: SK036093). The path then heads west along Cobbett Road for approximately 31 metres (point D on the Order plan, Grid Ref: SK036093) before heading in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 141 metres (point E on the Order plan, Grid Ref: SK036092) before turning in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 40 metres (point F on the Order plan, Grid Ref SK037092). The path then heads in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 936 metres, crossing Robins Road and the A5190 to its junction with Public Footpath No. 0.333 Burntwood Parish (point G on the Order plan, Grid Ref: SK042084).

The path then heads west along Cobbett Road for approximately 31 metres (point D on the Order plan, Grid Ref: SK036093) before heading in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 141 metres (point E on the Order plan, Grid Ref: SK036092) before turning in a generally north-easterly direction for approximately 40 metres (point F on the Order plan, Grid Ref SK037092). The path then heads in a generally south-easterly direction for approximately 936 metres, crossing Robins Road and the A5190 to its junction with Public Footpath No. 0.333 Burntwood Parish (point G on the Order plan, Grid Ref: SK042084).

A copy of the Order and the Order map have been placed at the offices of Lichfield District Council, District Council House, Frog Lane, Lichfield, WS13 6YY, Burntwood Library, Sankeys Corner, Bridge Cross Road, Burntwood, WS7 2BX, and at the offices of Staffordshire County Council, Corporate Reception, St Chad's Place, Stafford and may be inspected free of charge during normal working hours Mondays to Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased.

Compensation for depreciation or damage for disturbance arising as a result of the coming into force of the Order is payable under section 28 (as applied by section 121(2)) of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended by the Transport and Works Act 1992).

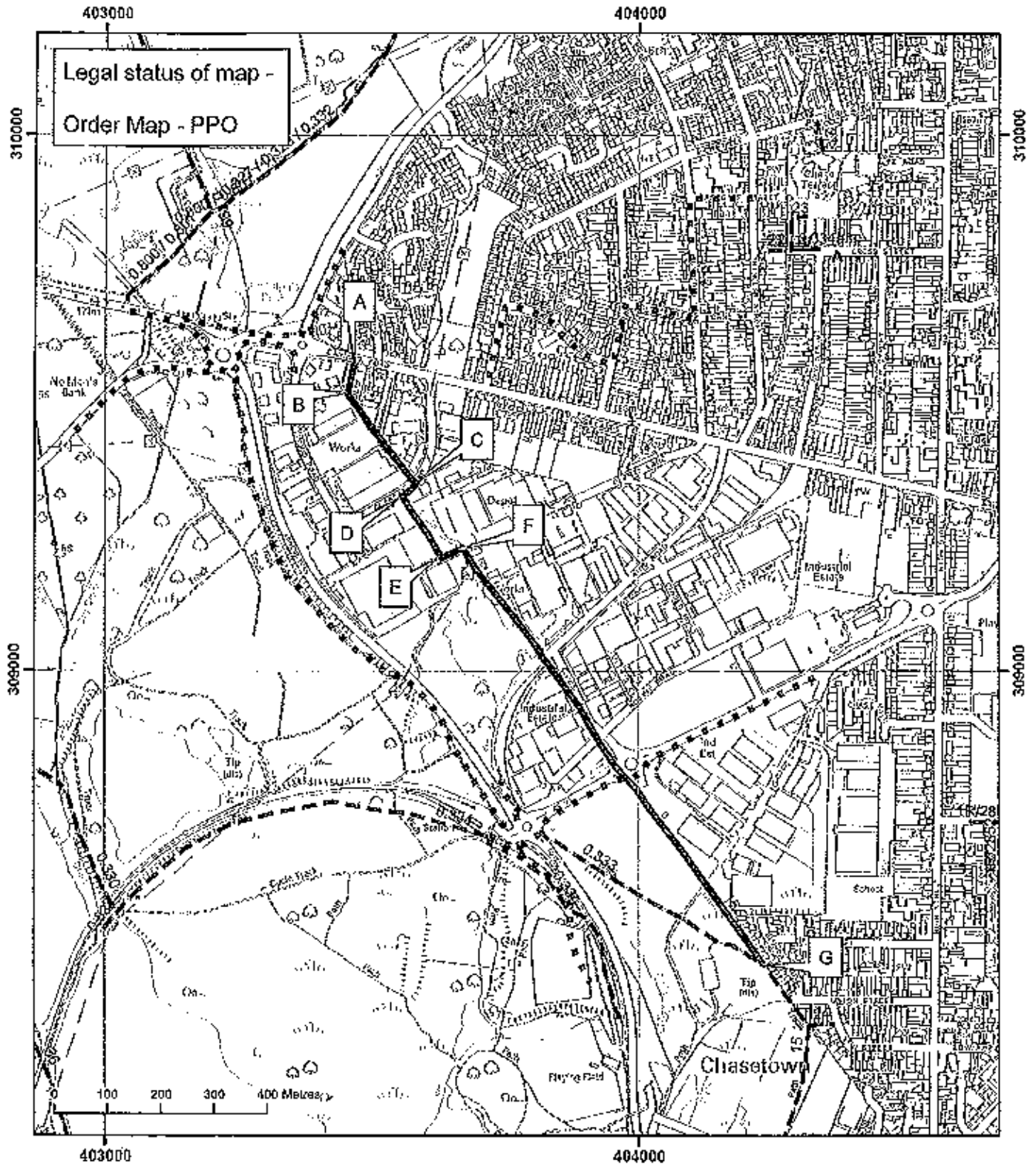

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn the Staffordshire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
