HOLLYWOOD COMES TO BURNTWOOD INIT

Burntwood Init will be giving the young people of Burntwood a slice of Hollywood thanks to a new cinema.

The latest multi-media projection system has been installed at the Youth Centre in Cherry Close, Burntwood. The mini cinema boasts a 10 foot screen and black modular seating units, which can seat up to 15 young people.

The room is available for hire, free of charge, to groups of young people aged 11 to 19 years on the first Friday of every month between 8pm and 10 pm. Burntwood Init will pay for the movie, which can be up to a certificate 15. Moviegoers can even order pizza, and there will be refreshments and sweets on sale.

To attend the cinema, the young people need to be living or attending school in Burntwood. They also need parental consent if they are watching a film with a certificate older than their age.

Julie Aleksejuk, Burntwood Init Co-ordinator, said: "The cinema set-up we have is fantastic and really recreates the atmosphere of going to the movies. It's already proving to be tremendously popular with the young people and is a great way of keeping people occupied on a Friday night".
