What are the Community Wardens?

Ann Harvey, Mel Brown, Sally Jones and Beverley Gardiner are the Community Wardens for Burntwood. Patrolling together in their green and white uniforms they carry ID cards, first aid pouches and mobile phones.

What are the Community Wardens?

The Community Wardens are non-confrontational and are not substitute police officers. They have the same powers and rights as ordinary citizens.

Burntwood sometimes suffers from problems like nuisance behaviour, vandalism, graffiti, litter and accidental damage. The Community Wardens are helping to ensure that these problems are properly dealt with in a speedy and efficient manner.
