Speed Indicator Devices

Burntwood Town Council have acquired two Speed Indicator Devices as a result of a successful grant application to the Staffordshire Safer Road Partnership. The mobile signs are designed to display vehicle speed as motorists approach. The purpose of radar speed signs is to slow cars down by making drivers aware then they are driving at speeds above the posted limits. The intention is that the signs will be installed at various locations in the Parish of Burntwood where known traffic speeds have been identified as a problem and will be moved from time to time.
