

Burntwood Cemetery
Walled memorial – rules and regulations
With effect from 5 June 2021

1. Cut flowers, evergreens and bouquets may be placed on the stoned area in front of the wall, to commemorate an anniversary. The Council shall not be held responsible for any items that may go missing.
2. No permanent ornaments, windmills, lanterns, wind chimes or plants are to be placed on the stoned area.
3. The management of the Cemetery will be undertaken by the Council and will include the maintenance of all lawns, trees and shrubs.
4. The Council reserves the right to remove flowers/wreaths for maintenance purposes and to remove them permanently when they are withered.
5. The Cemetery will be open to the public for visiting daily as follows:
9.00 a.m. until 4.00 p.m. 01 October – 31 March
9.00 a.m. until 6.00 p.m. 01 April – 30 September
6. The Council Offices are situated at The Old Mining College Centre, Queen Street, Chasetown, Burntwood WS7 4QH and are open for the transaction of business from 9.00 am to 5pm on Monday-Thursday and 9.00 am to 4.30 pm on Friday. The Office will not be open on Saturdays, Sundays, public or bank holidays and any other day set aside by the Council as a holiday.
